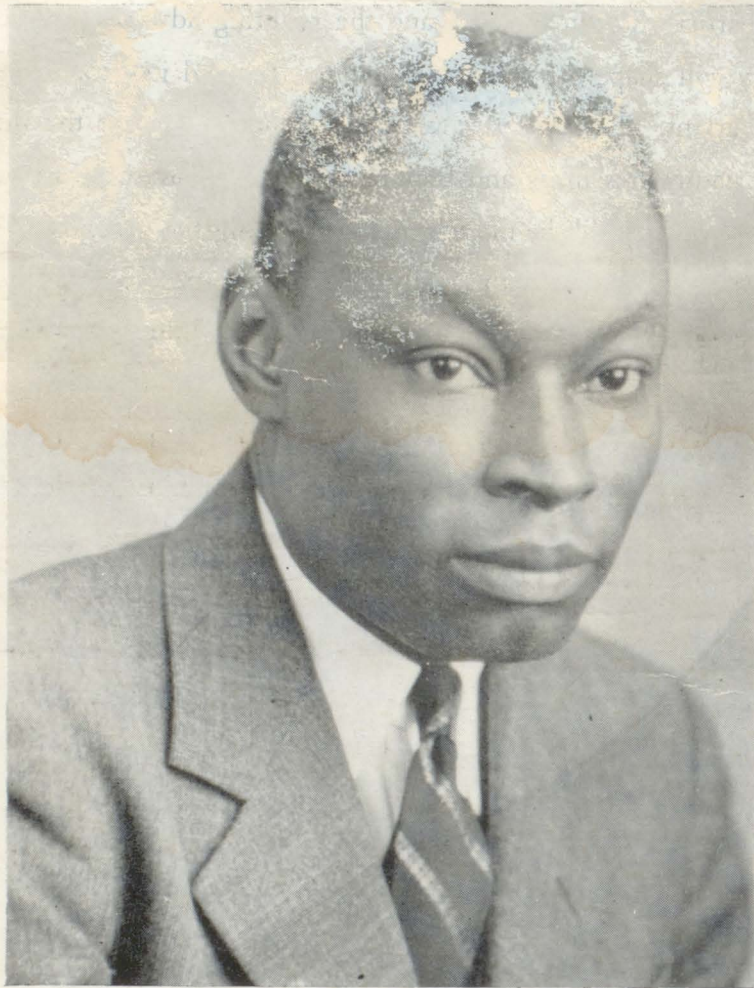


## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

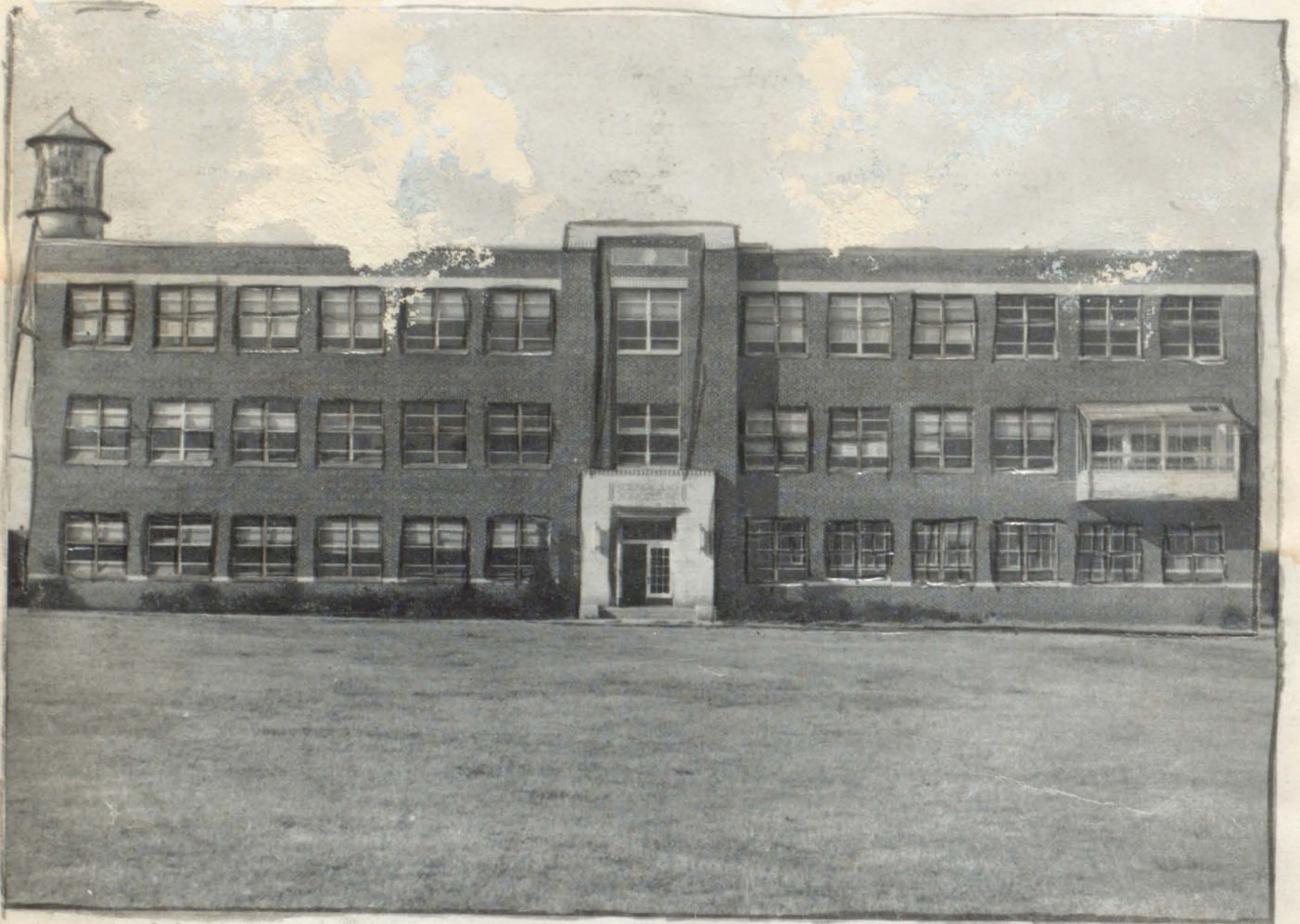
## Message From The Academic Dean
